▶ Eating Disorders are becoming more prevalent and severe. Sufferers are presenting in all different arenas, from primary care, through to acute care and specialist services as well as schools, colleges and universities. These patients are high risk and complex, and can be challenging to manage.

Due to the complexity of the condition, clinicians, allied health professionals and care-givers across all domains, require skill, knowledge and confidence to help sufferers with eating disorders.

Our one-day training course includes eating disorder diagnosis, classification, aetiology, management of very high-risk cases, an overview of clinical presentations including risk assessment, treatments of eating disorders, clinical scenarios, an overview of the use of the Mental Health Act, mental capacity issues, decision making and recent case law.

▶ This training day will provide you with an overview of the range of eating disorders commonly seen. The following questions will be explored:

- How do I know if someone has an eating disorder?
- What are the features of the different types of eating disorders?
- Why does someone get an eating disorder and why is it so hard to treat?
- What are the signs, symptoms, and risks of eating disorders?
- How do I help someone with an eating disorder?
- How do I treat someone with an eating disorder?
- What help is available for someone with an eating disorder?
- What are the risks?
- What is MARSIPAN?
- What about the MHA, MCA and Court of Protection? Are there any other legal aspects?
- How do I assess someone with an eating disorder under the MHA and what drives the decisions?

- Diagnostic criteria and case study discussion
- Aetiological factors - predisposing, precipitating and maintaining factors
- Why patients can be so difficult to treat
- MARSIPAN (Management of Really Sick Patients with Anorexia Nervosa)
- Typical cases of anorexia nervosa and bulimia nervosa: signs and symptoms, risk factors and advice to help form decisions
- Treatments in the community and inpatient settings

▶ Expert Speaker: Dr Matthew Cahill

Dr Matthew Cahill MBBS MRCPsych DipPsychMed is a Consultant Psychiatrist and Clinical Lead for the Cheshire and Wirral Partnership Eating Disorder Service. He is the Academic Secretary of the Royal College of Psychiatrists Faculty of Eating Disorders Executive Committee, a member of the North West regional MARSIPAN (Management of Really Sick Patients with Anorexia Nervosa) Group, and an Honorary Clinical Tutor at Liverpool University. He leads three community clinics and a fourteen-bedded eating disorder inpatient unit covering a population of four million. Matthew treats patients with a range of eating disorders including anorexia nervosa, bulimia nervosa, binge eating disorders amongst others, working in a multidisciplinary approach, sharing skills with dietitians, social workers, psychologists, eating disorder practitioners and occupational therapists. He works closely with families and carers. Matthew understands how devastating these disorders can be for the individual, those close to them, and clinicians involved with their care, and he is passionate about sharing his knowledge and experience to help anyone manage these complex illnesses.

▶ Target audience / who should attend:

All psychiatrists, GPs, mental healthcare professionals, social care staff and other health care professionals who work with eating disorder patients.

▶ Learning modes

The course will be delivered using a range of learning modes including: presentation, discussion, Q&A and group case study work.

- The evidence base - medication options, different therapies
- Behaviours to look out for in complex cases.
- The influences of media, pro-anorexia websites, social media etc. and the impact on carers
- Treatment options for the future including deep brain stimulation
- Case study discussion
- Legal aspects which including use of MCA, MHA, advanced decisions, CTOs, and capacity within eating disorders
- High profile cases and complex cases

▶ Accreditation
